In your browser search for the following website:

At the top click “Community”, then “Reviews”

Scroll down and click on “Ham Radio Education & Exam Prep Materials”

On the second column click on “# Reviews” 2x. This will sort preparation resources with the most reviews to the top.

Whatever you choose make sure the resource was updated as of July 1, 2022.

Volunteer Examiners in the club favor the following:

1. HamTestOnline – An online web-based resource that tracks your progress. A free trial is available before you buy.
2. Gordon West Written Elements Study Guide – The reviews are old and the link is out of date. Go to w5yi.org. There are a lot of illustrations, charts, diagrams and other visuals in the book.
3. ARRL License Manuals – These are very good for explaining the theory the material is based on. The link is out of date. The current link is <https://home.arrl.org/action/Store/Product-Details/productId/2002476141>. Scroll down this page and click on [View More](#) for free videos which are available to use with the book.
4. KB6NU Technician License Exam Study Guide – The reviews are old. After clicking on the link click on [Study Guides](#) at the top. There you will see a free pdf download. 127 pages long for the 7/1/2022 edition. A Kindle version is available for \$10.
5. Extra Class the Easy Way by K4IA – There is no review for the Technician Class but you can click on the link to see it. Make sure you order the 2022 edition because both editions are available for sale. It emphasizes that only right answers are printed to prevent confusion.
